From the Pastor

Dear Friends,

As the weather tries to improve and we move past our Easter celebration, Our Parish will move into an active construction mode. Toward the end of fall in 2023, we reached a settlement with Church Mutual, the Diocese property insurance carrier, for hail damage to our parish buildings. All of our buildings were affected and will see major repairs. We have contracted with River City Roofing to complete the repairs. All slanted roofs will be replaced along with all mansards.

This is a major project for our Parish and will surely produce trying circumstances. Fortunately, the majority of the funds necessary have already been paid by Church Mutual and sit in our coffers. The remaining balance, which includes our property deductible, will approximate \$18,000.00. Funds we will need to pay from our Capital Improvement budget.

As this project is completed, all roof surfaces, with the exception of the Center's flat roof, will be new and hopefully should secure us from problems for several years to come, barring repeated severe occurrences.

We ask for your patience and understanding during this process and ask for your prayers for a successful completion. Good weather would be nice also!
