#### Sacramentals - Giveaway Sunday!

St Anthony Parish will be offering free sacramentals at all all masses on Aug 17-18. These will include rosary rings, Miraculous Medals, brown scapulars, and filled small holy water bottles.

According to the 'Catechism of the Catholic Church,' sacramentals 'are sacred signs which bear a resemblance to the sacraments. They signify effects, particularly of a spiritual nature, which are obtained through the intercession of the Church. By them men and women are disposed to receive the chief effect of the sacraments, and various occasions in life are rendered holy...Sacramentals do not confer the grace of the Holy Spirit in the way that the sacraments do, but by the Church's prayer, they prepare us to receive grace and dispose us to cooperate with it.'

The **rosary** is a powerful, time honored prayer of meditation on mysteries of our Lord Jesus set to the mantra of 'decades' of ten Hail Mary's each.

The **Miraculous Medal** is a powerful sign of Mary's closeness and presence to her children in Christ. Wearing one is like a grace magnet.

The **brown scapular** is another powerful sign of Mary's tender care for her children in Christ. Those enrolled in the scapular and who wear it devoutly have been promised to be spared from the fires of hell.

**Holy water** is meant to remind us of our baptism and the new life in Christ that was given to us through this wonderful sacrament. Holy water has been used to ward off evil in homes, invite heavenly blessings, and establish an atmosphere of faith and grace.

These 'sacramentals' will be available in church the weekend of Aug 17-18 and will remain available at the welcome center thereafter until they are all taken!
