## This Generous, Giving Parish!

Dear friends,

One of the most famous Scriptures is John 3:16: "For God so loved the world that he GAVE his only begotten Son..."

God is a GIVER. We are created in the image and likeness of this 'Giver' God. When we give, we are being like Him. That's why it feels so good!

I'd like to take a moment to acknowledge and bless St Anthony for its amazing spirit of giving.

When Fr Deus came in February for his mission appeal for his church in Tanzania, St Anthony gave more than \$12K.

When we put the 'Change for Change' bucket out during Lent, we raised \$1082 for helping needy students at two local schools.

When we gave 'Fill the Sack' bags for our local food pantry, we collected over 2400 pounds of food.

We donated \$13,400 to the St Vincent de Paul society last year for aid to local friends in need.

When you add that all up, along with the six other diocesan collections for extra-parish needs, St Anthony easily pays a tithe (10%) of its annual income to help the needy.

This is a sign of great spiritual health, and it bodes well for our future. Just look up the biblical promises attached to tithing, for example, Malachi 3:10:

Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse...' says the Lord, 'Test me in this, and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.'

In addition, St Anthony has exceeded the ADA goal every year, including rebates of about \$22K this year.

And we are 'in the black' financially as a parish thanks to the generous regular Sunday donations of our good people.

This is how we give our 'treasure.' We could go on to say much more about how we give of our time and talent. Just look at the garage sales!

Thanks for being such a giving parish! It needs to be said! May God bless you!
