From the Pastor

Thanks for the New Parking Lot!

Dear friends,

We are so happy with our new parking lot! We knew it was needed for a long time. We gathered estimates this Spring and chose the bid from Tazewell Asphalt for \$156K. We had only just received permission from the diocese of Peoria to complete this project when we learned the company had an unexpected window of time in June to complete it. And so we jumped at the chance, happy that we would not have to wait till Fall.

The cost was less expensive than we feared. I am happy to say that we had the funds to pay this off immediately with no loan (although our savings are now pretty depleted).

I want to say a word of heartfelt thanks to the parish. The reason we had the margin to pay for this upfront was because of your generosity. Healthy Sunday collections, large annual ADA rebates, and amazing Garage Sale returns made this possible. Sometimes people ask 'What does the parish do with all the money we make from the garage sales?' We save it! St Anthony had about \$80K in savings with the diocese loan fund as well as over \$80K in the capital improvements fund. We steward our resources wisely, so that the money is there when we need it.

I think it's important to state this plainly and often. St Anthony has a great finance council and shrewd trustees. We keep a detailed budget and stick to it, in fact we've finished in the black the past several years.

My friends, most parishes cannot just pull the trigger on a large project like a total parking lot redo using funds on hand. The fact that it was possible speaks to the health and generosity of our parish and the incredible hard work of our garage sale team. Thanks, and enjoy the smooth new parking lot!




