Dear friends,

Grace and peace to you in Jesus our Lord! I am so excited about Pope Leo 14's new Apostolic Exhortation 'Dilexite' on love for the poor and its inseparable connection to our love for Christ. I don't want to say much about it until I've had the time to study and prayerfully digest its contents. But from the little I've seen so far, it looks like it will make me uncomfortable in all the right ways while inspiring me towards ever greater 'pastoral conversion.'

Here is a sample passage that really spoke to me:

Christian love breaks down every barrier, brings close those who were distant, unites strangers, and reconciles enemies. It spans chasms that are humanly impossible to bridge and it penetrates to the most hidden crevices of society. By its very nature, Christian love is prophetic: it works miracles and knows no limits. It makes what was apparently impossible happen. Love is above all a way of looking at life and a way of living it. A Church that sets no limits to love, that knows no enemies to fight but only men and women to love, is the Church that the world needs today. (Paragraph 20)

Let's always pray for our beloved Holy Father and strive to listen to him with docility and love!
