# Parish Survey and Upcoming Parish Council Meeting

Nov 5, 6:30pm, Parish Center

A big 'Thank You' to everyone who submitted your parish survey! We had 121 submissions. The results will be printed and available on the welcome center counter for anyone who'd like a copy.

There were not a lot of surprises, in fact the results were quite encouraging. There is always room for improvement, of course, and our next step is to discern the results and prayerfully seek steps to respond positively in these areas. I have the numerical results, which are being shared with everyone, as well as the comments, which I and the staff plan on taking to prayer so as to discern what the Lord wants from us as a parish. I like to follow the 'see-judge-act' methodology used by the Church in her social teachings. This method involves, first, taking in the data as clearly and objectively and thoroughly as possible (See). Second, taking the data to prayer and, in counsel with others, seeing what it is saying and what actions we are in fact positioned to take to respond (Judge) Third, after this process, and only after, taking steps to respond as appropriate and within our power (Act).

Since the parish council came up with the great idea to do the survey, they are helping me in the process. But as part of this method, I invite anyone who wishes to attend our upcoming 'open' meeting. The invitation is intended to not only invite interested parishioners into the discernment process, but also to offer a trial meeting to those who might wish to be a part of parish council in the future. We recently lost several members whose term limits were up, and we could use some more voices to come on the council, which advises the pastor through meetings every other month.
