Line of David - Fact Check

Dear friends,

In the homily for the 4th Sunday of Advent, I mistakenly reported that only Joseph was of David's line, as I had learned.

I was corrected in this point. Here is what the Catholic app 'Truthly' says: 'Yes, Mary was of the line of David, which is significant because it fulfills the Old Testament prophecies that the Messiah would come from the house of David. While the Gospels do not provide an explicit genealogy for Mary, tradition and theological reflection suggest her Davidic lineage. In the Gospel of Luke, the angel Gabriel refers to Jesus as being given the throne of his father David, highlighting a connection to Davidic descent (Luke 1:32). Moreover, the early Church understood both Mary and Joseph to be of Davidic descent, which further underscores Jesus' rightful claim to the promises made to David. The genealogies presented in Matthew and Luke, though they primarily trace Joseph's lineage, indicate the importance of Davidic heritage in the Holy Family.'

I apologize for my mistake. I hope it's the last time I get my facts wrong. I will try to do better in the future.
