


St Anthony Welcomes Fr Adnan!

Lunch & Presentation Feb. 13 at Noon

Celebrating masses Feb. 14 & 15

Dear Friends,

As many of you know, I like to travel to San Diego each Spring with my brother Ben to visit a good priest friend. His name is Fr Adnan Ghani. He is a member of the Order of St Augustine (OSA), which happens to be the same order as Pope Leo (no, Fr Adnan doesn't know him personally!)



Fr Adnan is from Pakistan. He joined the California province of the Augustinians in 2014, and took his vows along with ordination in 2019. For the past seven years, he has worked as a hospital counselor/chaplain. Recently, he was asked by his order to return to Pakistan to begin an Augustinian mission, beginning with a retreat house.

Fr Adnan is excited for this amazing opportunity to spread the gospel and bring the wonderful Augustinian presence and mission back to his home country.

The project of starting the retreat house is a big challenge. Fr Adnan has had his hands full overseeing construction as well as raising funds. I invited him to St Anthony for both a visit and a mission appeal, which is an annual requirement for each parish. I'm so happy he was able to arrange his schedule to make it happen!

In addition to **celebrating masses with us and preaching on Feb 14-15**, Fr Adnan would like to get to know the parishioners and tell us about Pakistan. It's a Muslim country in the heart of the Middle East, where Christians are a tiny minority. Most of us will not have the chance to hear from someone like Fr Adnan with firsthand experience of such a place. Also, Fr Adnan is just an all-around great guy and I would love to get him acquainted with our wonderful people and vice versa.

We will have a simple **lunch of soup and sandwiches at St Anthony's parish center on Friday, Feb 13 at noon, followed by a presentation by Fr Adnan**. I hope you can make it!
