

Building on Hope Campaign Update

Dear friends,

I'd like to say a warm 'thank you' for your amazing response to our 'Building on Hope' campaign! As of this writing (1/23), we have received \$501K in pledges and \$317K in payments; with a total of 121 givers so far.

We launched the campaign in October with the goal of raising \$500K for solar panels and for a new Morton building. The solar will help us save money while powering our campus more sustainably and responsibly. The new Morton building will provide a larger and nicer space for our garage sales and other parish uses.

We are already putting the money to work. Our rectory solar panels were installed in December and are now up and running. We just signed the contract to install the panels to power the church and parish center. These will be installed in late Spring or early summer on the southwest portion of our campus.

The total upfront cost for the total campus solar project \$400K. About 3/4 of this will come back to us in rebates. To help us cover the initial costs, we are approved for a loan from the Diocese for a maximum of \$200K, to be taken as needed. We hope to pay off the loan within a few years using the rebate money plus incoming pledges.

Our hope is to complete the solar this year, pay it off, and erect the new Morton building in 2027.

We are still accepting new pledges. If you have not made a pledge yet, please prayerfully consider doing so. Keep in mind that everything we make over our goal remains exempt from future ADA assessments. In addition, a cushion in our campaign account will give us considerable freedom to build the biggest and best Morton building possible to meet our future needs.

As pastor of St Anthony's, I continue to be amazed and edified by the generosity of our people. Thank you for your prayerful and generous support of St Anthony's. Please keep it up, as we look forward to bright future together!




St. Anthony's Annual Pancake and Sausage Breakfast
