with weekly reflections on Christ's sufferings today in His people


Honoring and remembering Christ's many sorrows on His way to Calvary is a beautiful Lenten tradition. By meditating on the 'Stations of the Cross,' we disciples are moved to see Christ's incredible love for us poured out, and to imitate the love on behalf of others.

Christ continues to endure many 'stations' today in and through His suffering poor, with whom he identified himself when he said: "Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these, my brethren, you did it to me." (Matthew 25:40)

In order to help us connect the sufferings of Christ with His people today, St. Anthony is having a reflection each week to begin our Stations meditations. We will hear from a speaker who works locally on behalf of the poor, underprivileged, or suffering in our community. The speaker will connect a station with those they serve.

In this way, the Stations can hopefully be a challenge to conversion. The weekly reflections will inspire us with local applications of Catholic social doctrine, giving us insight to better see and love our neighbor through the social mission that flows from the Gospel.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church and the US Bishops insist that 'Catholic social teaching is a central and essential element of our faith.' May these Lenten Stations and their corresponding reflections help us to better understand and put into practice the Gospel and Catholic social doctrine, putting love into action on behalf of others.


