Soon-to-be Blessed Archbishop Fulton Sheen (1895 – 1979), theologian, scholar, and evangelist wrote the following:

"The Cross had asked the questions; the Resurrection had answered them. ...The Cross had asked: "Why does God permit evil and sin to nail Justice to a tree?" The Resurrection answered: "That sin, having done its worst, might exhaust itself and this be overcome by Love that is stronger than either sin or death."

Sometimes, it might feel like sin and evil will never exhaust themselves. They still labor constantly to thwart the good creation of God and the peace and happiness of peoples. But...always in vain. Unexpected good always ends up sprouting in where evil has seemingly won. Good Friday always has its Easter, thanks to God's ultimate victory in Christ.

Archbishop Sheen also once said: 'Evil has its hour, but God has his day.' Good Friday gives way to Easter Sunday! He is risen indeed! Halleluia!

May the Resurrection of Jesus Christ fill your hearts with joy and your minds with hope! We are destined for glory, not shame. Happy Easter!

STATEMENT REGARDING BEATIFICATION DETAILS OF ARCHBISHOP FULTON J. SHEEN

From Bishop Louis Tylka, Diocese of Peoria

“With great joy and deep gratitude to God, I am pleased to announce the Mass for the Beatification of the Venerable Servant of God, Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen, will take place on Thursday, September 24, 2026, at 2 pm Central time at The Dome at America’s Center in St. Louis. With anticipation of a great number of people wanting to participate, we chose this location because of availability, being indoors, and the close proximity to the Diocese of Peoria. The Beatification will be celebrated by Cardinal Luis Tagle, who has been nominated as the Papal Representative. In addition, there will be a number of events in Peoria to celebrate this wonderful occasion.

This is a moment of immense grace for the Church—especially for us in the Diocese of Peoria, where Archbishop Sheen was born, ordained, and first served as a priest. His life and ministry continue to inspire countless people to know and love Jesus Christ more deeply. Through his preaching, teaching, and personal witness, he brought the light of faith to millions, calling each of us to a deeper devotion to the Eucharist and to Our Blessed Mother.

The Beatification Mass will be a profound moment of prayer and celebration for the faithful near and far. I invite all who have been touched by Archbishop Sheen’s life and legacy to join us in spirit or in person for this historic event.
