



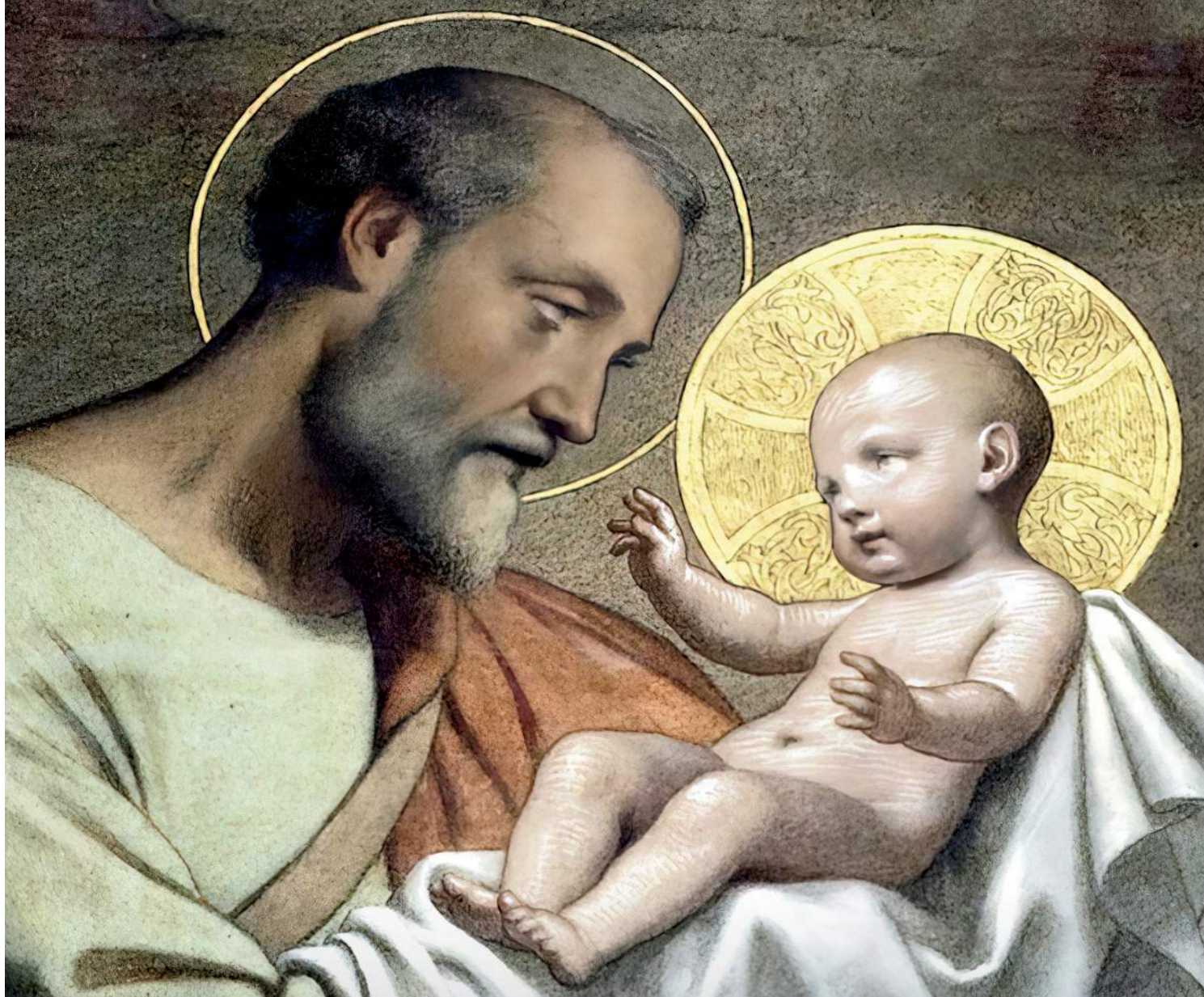

Solar Panel Planting

Recently, several parishioners volunteered to take responsibility for sections of our new garden plot around the solar panels. They have worked hard to plant a bunch of wonderful native plants. These will mature and fill-in more every year, attract pollinators, and contribute to a healthy ecosystem around our beautiful campus.

As these plants mature, we hope to harvest the seeds for more plantings around campus. We would even love to eventually have a Spring plant sale every year so that others can benefit from our wonderful native plants.

The volunteers will weed, water, and oversee the plot, and mulch when needed. Please note that these plants will not 'pop' immediately. For a year or two, they will be unimpressive - small and green and maybe not too colorful. THEY ARE NOT WEEDS - PLEASE DO NOT PULL THEM OR INTERFERE WITH THEIR DEVELOPMENT!

I promise you, in a few years, with a little effort and patience, they will look amazing!

Also, FYI - the rest of the solar panels, those powering the church and parish center, will be installed sometime this Fall. The supply chain for the rebate-qualifying panels is quite backed up due to high demand. We will be preparing that space on the SW corner of the property this summer. Eventually, we would like to plant pollinators around the area as well. However, it will be a huge space and so this will be a work-in-progress.

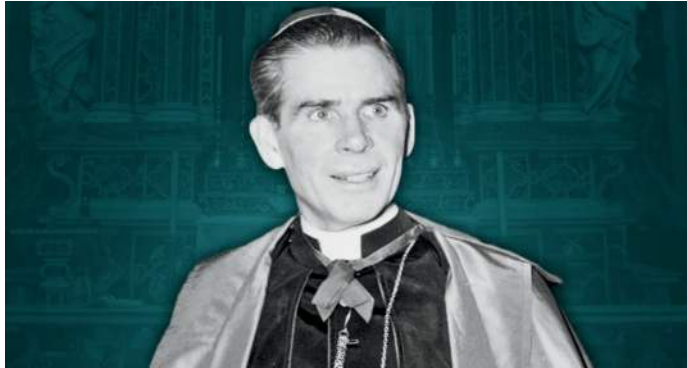

Baptismal Font

One of my favorite features of our wonderful church is the baptismal font. Its placement as you enter church is perfect - from the font to the altar! Now that's some solid theology!

The planners and designers of St Anthony church put lots of thought and love into the font. Its gentle flow has personally brought me so much peace and comfort in the early morning hours when I pray in the darkened church alone.

Unfortunately, there are technical issues with the font. After thirty years, it seems the supply lines have developed leaks. These are under the church and not easily accessible without major disruptions. Dan Hordesky and Steve Thomas have spent countless hours over the last month trying to diagnose and solve the problems, to no avail. Kudos to them for their valiant efforts.

So where are we at?

Sometime in the future, we will look into the possibility of replacing the lines though a process of 'boring.' This may or may not be possible; it will depend on how accessible the plumbing is. The font was not given an access panel, so to go in and have a look at the supply pipe configuration will require removing some bricks. This will be dusty and unsightly, at least for a time.

If the pipes can be replaced through boring, and it's not prohibitively expensive, then this is a desirable solution. But otherwise, we will have to look into other possibilities, such as installing an attractive refillable bowl in the top level of the font and using the lower level for decorative purposes.

Let's let Fr Jim get settled in and go from there. Dan and Steve are deeply invested in the font and know a great deal about its history and workings. If it can be saved in its intended fashion, it will. But we're not going to tear up the church floor and spend ridiculous sums of money to fix it.

Thanks for your patience in this matter. Please pray for a divine fix. Stay tuned!
