He also is happy to receive mail from us. His new address is:

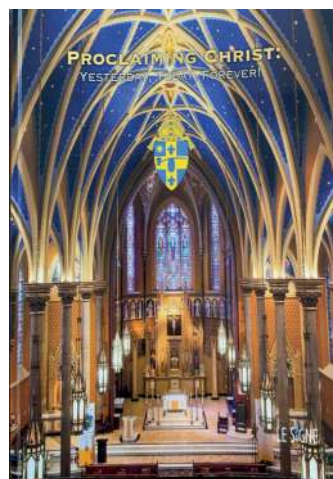
