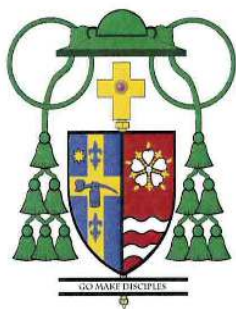

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

"You will be my witnesses ... to the ends of the earth." (*Acts 1:8*) These words, spoken by Jesus to His followers nearly two thousand years ago, resound with particular meaning in this moment in the life of our diocese as our soon-to-be-Blessed Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen is held up as a witness of Christ worthy of imitating.

I have chosen these words of Jesus as our theme for this year's Annual Diocesan Appeal. I hope this historic moment will renew in each of us a deeper commitment to being credible witnesses of Christ in the world today.

(*Heb 12:1*) Your prayerful and generous financial support of our Annual Diocesan Appeal sustains the vital diocesan ministries that serve the faithful and strengthen our Church. They provide ministry support that no single parish could accomplish on its own.
